## September 2012 – Prayer Focus

This month in our prayer focus we will concentrate on ministries within CFSR. They are listed in no particular order & hold equal importance in our prayers.

**Pastor Ivor & Carol** – Ivor and Carol are dedicated to CFSR, to the members. They are concerned with every part of our lives and with the long-term future of the church.

**Leadership Team** – This group of volunteers from the CFSR congregation meet regularly and work for the benefit of the entire church. They make decisions and take responsibility for the church and the members.

*Children & young people will be the church of the future. It is incredibly important for us to help build them up in God.*

**Sunday School** – There are 3 classes each week, catering for ages between 3-12 years. Teachers are needed, currently on a 2 week on/6 week off rota. There is teaching material already prepared for each class.

**Youth Group** – This newly formed group aims to serve our teens as they move toward adulthood and as they become more responsible for their deepening relationship with God.

**Worship Teams** – This is a vital ministry as each team seeks to lead the congregation into true worship of our Living God.

**Prison Visiting** – A small group of men have been visiting expat prisoners in Siem Reap Prison as part of Prison Fellowship in Cambodia. These men are so lost and need mature Christians to reach out to them, right where they are, regardless of what they have done.



**Bible Studies** – There are several Bible Studies being held each week, in an effort to provide opportunities for everyone to be a part of a group.

**Beyond Narnia** – A group that centres on the writings of C S Lewis, this group has been established to reach out to non-Christian expats living in Siem Reap. It aims to provide a non-threatening atmosphere where any question at all can be asked without fear of judgement or ridicule.

**Technical Crew** – This includes the sound desk and the preparation & operation of presentations in services, both for worship and sermons.

**Snack Crew** – The people who provide refreshments at the end of the services are key in encouraging an atmosphere that is welcoming, allowing people the space & time to get to know each other better.

**Ushering/Greeters** – Welcoming people, handing out leaflets, finding seats, passing out microphones, doing any other job that is asked of them, this team is important to the welcoming atmosphere of CFSR.

**Coordinators** – Currently we have people in the roles of Women's, Praise & Worship, Hospitality/Greeters, Finance & Bulletin Coordinators. This leaves gaps in the Men's, Technical Crew, Prayer & Sunday School roles. These people provide a central contact point for people interested in activities in those areas of CFSR life.

**Men's/Women's Ministries** – Catering for the different needs of men & women, and to give each space, events/meetings are organised as needed.
